CRITERIA FOR MONETARY GRANTS

The overall aim of the Manx Stroke Foundation is to help and support people after stroke. Financial difficulties may prevent people from acquiring the assistance needed. Persons may apply for monetary grants in order to provide assistance that will improve the person's quality of life and/or aid independence.

ELIGIBILITY:

Any person who has had a stroke or is caring for someone who has had a stroke can apply for a grant.

All other sources of funding must be explored first. Medical and rehabilitation equipment that can be provided by the Health or Social Services cannot be funded by the Manx Stroke Foundation.

All requests must be made in writing using the application form which can be obtained from the secretary or downloaded from the Manx Stroke Foundation website.

FUNDING CATEGORIES AND LIMITS:

The fund may provide up to a maximum of £1000 per applicant per annum.

Applications for specialist equipment such as powered wheelchairs, mobility scooters, hoists, specialist seating and car adaptations must include letters of support as to why this equipment is essential and recommendations from the relevant professional (e.g. physiotherapist or occupational therapist).

The Manx Stroke Foundation cannot accept responsibility for the ordering or the repairs, breakdown, servicing and maintenance of any items funded by them or liability for any injury or damage caused in the use of the equipment.

FUNDING WILL NOT BE PROVIDED FOR:

- Private medical treatment and private therapy
- Labour costs/structural alterations
- Nursing home fees other than respite
- Debts and rent arrears
- Items for which statutory funding is available

Grants cannot be provided retrospectively.

The request will be considered by the committee and applicants will be notified in due course. Each request is determined on its own merit and the committee may not always grant the full amount. The committee reserves the right to decline any request.

To ensure the request is dealt with as soon as possible applications should be submitted before the last day of each month.
